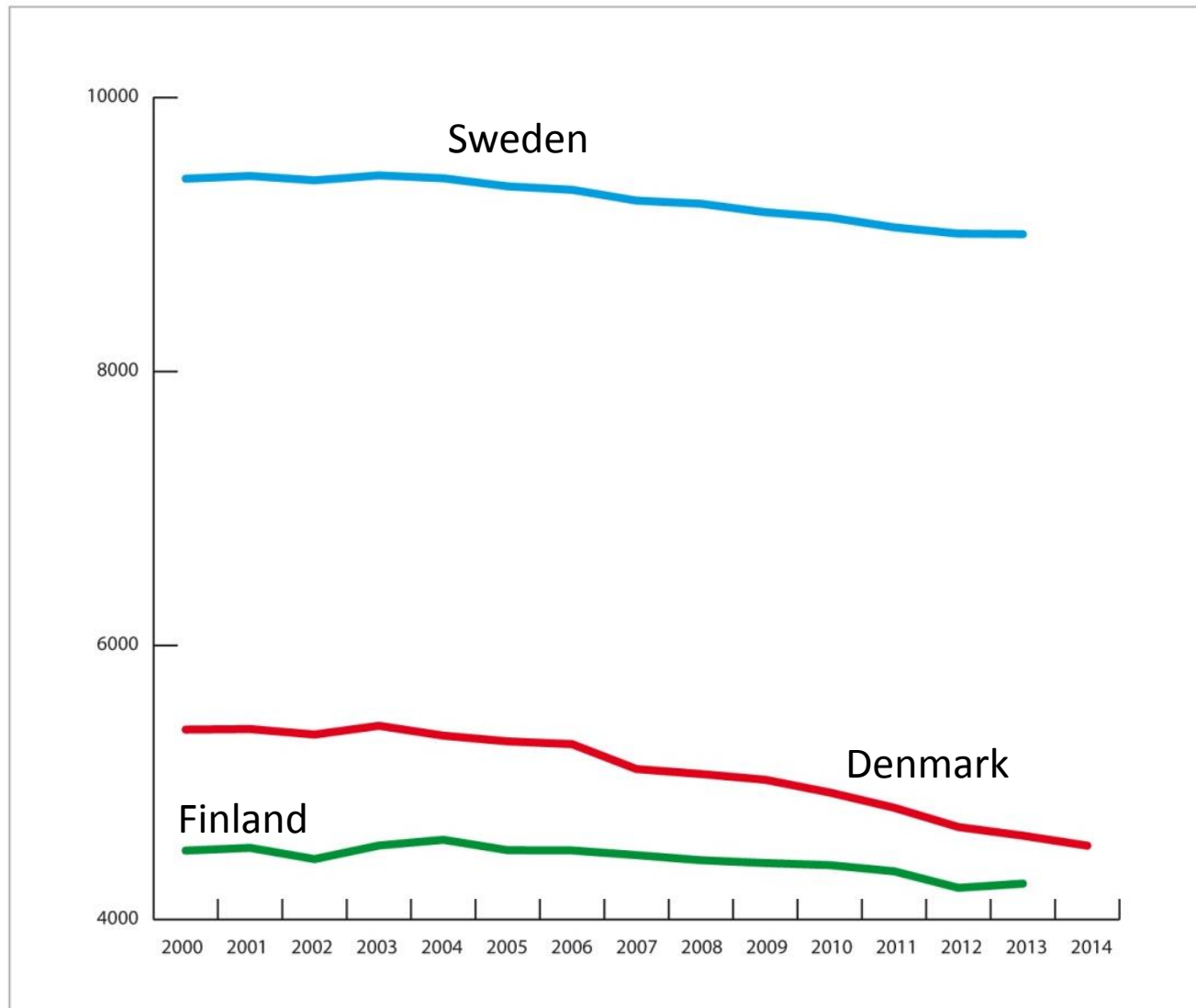

Next stop – small islands



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- Establish local investment opportunities
- Ensure that the local companies work together as partners instead of competitors
- Establish local groups that work with development and possibilities of establishing new jobs
- To take control of the housing on the island

What can be done?

On the level of the local municipality:

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- Ensure that the management of resources is coordinated with the local stakeholders
- Supporting the establishing of local investment opportunities

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- Start up the mapping of island communities potentials and resources
- “Up-grade” national politicians on islands issues

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On a national – and on EU – level

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- Basic needs regarding transport, fundamental services such as access to social services, day care facilities and full network coverage for telecom services
- Loaning and financing is made possible
- Flexibility in the interpretation of laws (do they make sense in the small island communities ?)

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- New idea: compare - in each country - demographic statistics for the rural districts *in general* with data *specifically* for the small islands.
